Fencing Central Regional Epee Squad



Position Description:

Fencing Central is calling for expressions of interest for Coach of its Regional Epee Squad program.

The intention of the program is to create a focused training environment for the top Central region fencers in each weapon to help further develop their competitive skills and ready them for high level national or international representation.

To lead this program, Fencing Central is looking for an experienced Epee coach who will planning, development and running of bi-monthly weekend training camps based in Brooklyn, Wellington.

Coaches will have the freedom to focus on a physical, technical and mental aspects of Fencing program participants.

Epee Squad training camps will be run on a yet to be determined schedule of dates, with the pilot camp scheduled to run on the 15th and 16th of November.

Requirements:

- Current Member of Fencing New Zealand

- Current Fencing New Zealand Accredited Coach
- Can demonstrate experience in developing and running fencing programs and/or coaching to International level
- Able to work in a mentoring role with assistant/development coach

Preferred Applicant Skills/Traits:

- Strong Communication skills
- Experience with working with and adapting to a range of different coaching styles to reflect variety of different backgrounds of program participants
- Candidates requiring minimal travel and/or accommodation for camps are preferred

Reimbursement details:

\$150 per day (\$300 for the full weekend). Food and drink provided. Some travel reimbursement may be provided if needed, at the discretion of Fencing Central Committee.
