Grant Tweddle asked why the competition revenues for Fencing Central have decreased from previous years. Will explained that due to Fencing Central being successful in obtaining grants to cover venue costs for the

National Open in October 2024, and the generosity of Feilding Sabres in withholding venue costs for the North Island Champs, Fencing Central had decided to pass these cost savings onto competitors, by not increasing competition entry costs, leading to competition revenue being down for 2024. Raising competition fees will be discussed by the 2025 Fencing Central committee.
